



Margaret Mary Mulligan married Michael Finn in 1916 and he opened a garage in property belonging to Mulligans on Barrack St [now Rafter St] but used 16 Main St as its address.

Their son Joe expanded the business and installed petrol pumps on the Main St before re-locating to the Arklow Road. Joe married Peggy Britton.

Sean Stafford a native of Wexford town moved to Gorey in 1955. Initially renting Byrne's Bakery on the Main St. In the late 1970's they built a new Bakery and Supermarket . Five years later the premises was purchased by Pettitt's . Staffords Bakery set up on Rafter Street , where Joannes Coffee Shop remains to the present day. Staffords also run Joannes Coffee Shops in Wexford & Arklow. His wife Lucy Doyle from Arklow was responsible for the running of Joannes in Arklow as well as Lucy Doyle's Restaurant. Staffords Bakery, is now one of the largest employers in Co.Wexford, supplying bread and confectionary all over the country.. The Bakery is now situated at Clonattin.
