Hannah Ebbs is a watchmaker according to Bassett's Directory but she also had property to rent on the Main St.

Samuel Clarke was the publisher of the Gorey Correspondent newspaper which was published from 1861 to 1892 when it was incorporated into the Enniscorthy Recorder.

Eliza OBrien was involved with her husband in the running of 17 and 18. One was a millenery shop and the other a licenced premises/ grocery. See no 17 for further details.

Thos Carroll was a sailor from Wexford town who married Catherine O'Connor, a national teacher in Ballyfad in 1906. He took over this premises about 1924 and continued to run it till his daughter Mary Anne [Mollie ] took over. The family had reintroduced the "O " into the name. Catherine died in 1953 and Thomas died in 1960 aged 88. Their daughter Oonagh trained as a musician and worked as a secretary in the Leather factory in Gorey. She played the organ in St Michaels for many years and passed away in 2013 at the age of 91, her sister Mollie preceding her in 1996.
