William Ebbs was a widower when he married Hannah Webster from Creagh in 1859. William's profession is given as being a watchmaker. He had married Eliza FitSimons in 1853 in Gorey. There were 4 children from the first marriage and one, Hannah born in 1861 from the second marriage. William died in 1879 aged 57 and his son WH Ebbs was the informant. William Ebbbs appears as a watchmaker in Slater's Directory in 1870 but it is Hannah who is listed as a watchmaker Main St Gorey in 1885 in Bassett's Directory. Hannah continued to run the business with her daughter Hannah Mary who took over fully following the death of her mother Hannah in Nov 1910. The Pearsons from North Parade who were related through their mother ran the shop from 1929 until Fred Godkin took over in 1956.
