The Stuart Family were living at 5 Main Street in the 1901 Census. William Stuart operated the boot making business having taken it over from his father Samuel in 1888 when Samuel died. On the 10th August , Anne Stuart (daughter of Samuel sister of William died aged 49. William Stuart married Eliza Earl in Hollyfort on the 5th February 1875. On the 25th Janauary 1879 Samuel Robert Stuart was born. On the 24th December 1881 Elizabeth Anne [Stewart] was born. On the 26th November 1886 Elizabeth Anne Stuart (Lilly) was born. She died on the 29th June 1909 aged 23. On April 13th 1884 Thomas Edward [Stewart] was born. On the 6th November 1887 Mary-Anne Stuart was born. On the 12th January 1890 William George Stuart was born. On the 12th June 1893 Charles Wallace Stuart was born. He died on the 5th February 1896 aged 2.

The Stuart Family with William at the helm are again listed as living at 5 Main Street. William died on the 12^{th} of April 1918 aged 79. The informant was his son Samuel who then took over the business. Elizabeth Stuart died on the 16^{th} July 1933 aged 75. Mary –Anne Stuart married William Reaney on the 19^{th} July 1916. Samuel Stuart married Alice Walker (daughter of Thomas Walker Blacksmith) on the 29^{th} October 1919.
