**...Stuart, William, Main Street**

The Stuart Family were living at 5 Main Street in the 1901 Census. William Stuart operated the boot making business having taken it over from his father Samuel in 1888 when Samuel died. On the 10<sup>th</sup> August, Anne Stuart (daughter of Samuel sister of William) died aged 49. William Stuart married Eliza Earl in Hollyfort on the 5<sup>th</sup> February 1875. On the 25<sup>th</sup> January 1879 Samuel Robert Stuart was born. On the 24<sup>th</sup> December 1881 Elizabeth Anne [Stewart] was born. On the 26<sup>th</sup> November 1886 Elizabeth Anne Stuart (Lilly) was born. She died on the 29<sup>th</sup> June 1909 aged 23. On April 13<sup>th</sup> 1884 Thomas Edward [Stewart] was born. On the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1887 Mary-Anne Stuart was born. On the 12<sup>th</sup> January 1890 William George Stuart was born. On the 12<sup>th</sup> June 1893 Charles Wallace Stuart was born. He died on the 5<sup>th</sup> February 1896 aged 2.

The Stuart Family with William at the helm are again listed as living at 5 Main Street. William died on the 12<sup>th</sup> of April 1918 aged 79. The informant was his son Samuel who then took over the business. Elizabeth Stuart died on the 16<sup>th</sup> July 1933 aged 75. Mary –Anne Stuart married William Reaney on the 19<sup>th</sup> July 1916. Samuel Stuart married Alice Walker (daughter of Thomas Walker Blacksmith) on the 29<sup>th</sup> October 1919.

On the 1911 Census No 6 Main Street is listed as a private dwelling. The Clarkes came to Gorey from England and William is a Postmaster. What is interesting is that the family filled in 'NONE' to their religion. Unusual for 1911 especially in Ireland where there was such a religious divide..
