The premises was rented as a house offices and yard. John Bates was a carpenter/coach builder. He died in 1853 aged 42 and is buried in the graveyard in Market Square.

John Bates wife Susan became the tenant. The tenancy was weekly, determinable each Saturday and paying two shillings per week. She died in Dublin aged 84.

George Ponder married Mary Bates, daughter of John and Susan in Hollyfort Church in 1870. He moved to Dublin. The 1901 Census recorded him as living in the Summerhill area Dublin as a cabinet maker. He died in 1914

Bassetts Guide of 1885 stated that Patrick Rourke was a Newsagent

There were no persons recorded as living here at the date of the 1901 Census.

Thomas Byrne was a mason and a building contractor. He was from Gorey Hill. In 1891, he married Catherine Crane from Ballingarry, Gorey. The 1901 census recorded them as living in Tomsilla, Gorey. The 1911 census recorded that they were living here with five of their six surviving children. Catherine died in 1918 due to influenza, aged 51 years. Thomas never remarried and died in 1947 aged 80 years. They are buried together in St Michael's Cemetery, Gorey.

Local knowledge remembers a confectionary shop operating here. Mollie was the daughter of Thomas Byrne and died in 1974. She is buried in St Michaels Cemetery Gorey near her parents.

John Gibbons, the grandson of Thomas Byrne became the owner of the property. His family continues to live there, operating a successful, well known florist shop.
