The marriage of Julia Sheehan and Andrew French is available on Irishgenealogy.ie. Andrew French a bachelor farmer of Ballyshannon age 36 years son of James French a farmer married Julia Sheehan a spinster of Ballyshannon age 28 years daughter of Michael Sheehan a farmer in the Shannon Chapel Enniscorthy 5/11/1875. The townland of Ballyshannon is in the parish of Newbawn in the south of Wexford but since the French and Sheehan family connections are all from around Gorey with a Sheehan and French family living in Ballyshane Craanford, So one could take it that the priest misheard it and should read Ballyshane. Andrew French died in 1896 and is buried in Toome graveyard with his children who died young. Julia French died in 1909 and is buried in Craanford with the Sheehans ,her family.
