Kirwan's Butcher Shop

Patrick Flusk who was a son of Barnaby Flusk and Ellen Darcy who held the premises now known as Browne's had married Annie FitzSimmons from Wicklow town in 1895 and they had one child Eileen born in 1899. Patrick's victualling business seems to have run into trouble as by 1905 he had promised to make a settlement and to give up the premises after having an ejectment order served on him. There is no sign of Patrick in the 1911 census but his wife is residing with her married sister Margaret Collins in Dundrum and Eileen their daughter is staying with her grandfather Patrick FitzSimmons, a grocer in Wicklow town. There is no death record to be found for Patrick Flusk in

Ireland and he does not appear in the 1911 census in England and Wales or in 1910 census in USA. When Eileen, his daughter got married in 1931 she lists Patrick as her father but does not state whether he is deceased or not and also leaves his profession blank.

Moses Kirwan was the incoming tenant in 1905 that Patrick Flusk made a settlement with. In the 1901 census Moses is living in Esmonde St with his wife Alicia [ nee Byrne ] and their 5 children. His profession is given as a farmer in1901 but when they got married in 1882 he gave his profession as a butcher. He ran a successful butchering business with his family all 5of whom seemed to be involved . None of them got married and the last of them Alice, passed away in 1976.

The shop had come into the possession of Mylie Doyle in 1966 who ran a traditional grocery store from behind the counter. His son now runs a select grocery from behind the same counter.
