House 103 in 1901 Census is now "Wayside" Arklow Rd.

Gorey Gas and Water Company, was located on lower Esmonde St, just under the Railway Bridge, the site now occupied by Aldi Supermarket. They produced gas to light the town of Gorey.

In 1901 Census of Ireland, Richard Creighton Age 55, married, Clerk of the Gorey Poor Law Union, born in Co. Carlow, was living at House No 103, Main Street, Gorey, a 2<sup>nd</sup> class, private built, 4 roomed house, owned by Richard Creighton. He was living with his daughter Jane Florence Age 22, born in Co. Wexford who worked as a teacher. His sister Jane Creighton (Age 57) was also living with him and a domestic servant, Mary Robin, Age 35 and from Co. Wexford.

In 1901 Census of Ireland Letitia Florence Edge Crighton wife of Richard Creighton, Age 50, Farmer, Church of Ireland, and born in Queens County, was living at House 11, Tankards Town, Carlow, Co Carlow along with her daughter Charlotte Age 25, born in Co. Wexford and Emelie, Age 11 born in Co Wexford . They had a domestic servant/gardener named John Keiffe (Age 61) living with them who was born in Co. Carlow House No 11 was owned by Letitia Crighton, a 2<sup>nd</sup> class, private built, 4 roomed house, with 10 outhouses. Leticia also owned House No 10, which was vacant, was a 2<sup>nd</sup> class privately built house, with 2 rooms and had 1 outhouse.

In 1911 Census of Ireland, Richard Creighton, Age 65, Married, from Co. Carlow, Church of Ireland, Clerk of the Gorey Poor Law Union, was living at House 70, Main Street, Gorey, Co Wexford. 2<sup>nd</sup> class. private dwelling, with 4 rooms. His daughter Jane Florence (Crighton) Kaye (Age 32) married, and her two sons, William Age 5, and Laurence Age 2, who were born in Canada. There was a general servant named Margaret Byrne, Age 30, from Co Wexford. Richard Crighton was the owner of House No 70.

In 1911 Census of Ireland, Letitia Florence Crighton, Age 60, married, from Queens County, Church of Ireland, and still living at House 11, Tankardstown, Co Carlow which she owned. She was living with her daughter Emily Lucy Creighton, Age 22. They had two servants living

with them, Patrick Abbey and Mary Abbey. It appeared from the census that the house 10 which she was the owner of in the 1901 census was now owned by Mr John O'Brien.
