Isaac Hutchinson listed himself as a Postmaster Grocer and Provisions, married Margaret Armstrong of Enniscorthy . There were three daughters Lucy Hannah, Ethel Margaret and Florence Mary, two sons


Francis Isaac an apprentice and Samuel Percy a scholar. There were two female servants recorded in residence. On the 20 June 1891 they lost a daughter Eleanor at 19 months of age.

In the 1911 Census Percy Samuel Hutchinson is in residence at 1 Charlotte Row, married and listed himself as a Wholesale and Retail Grocery Retail Merchant. Percy Samuel Hutchinson died on the 2 June 1924 at the age of thirty six.

In 1911 Isaac Hutchinson, describing himself as a Retired Civil Servant, along with the remainder of the family was living at 11 Villiniers Road, Rathgar and Rathmines in 1911.

William Stedmond ran a Grocery Shop along with his wife Margaret. They had three children Elizabeth, Eva and Eleanor. Their relative Mary Jane Slator was also in residence on the night of the census.
