The property then passed to Kealy & Murray partners who operated the Flowing Bowl Public House.

The property was bought by Ulster Bank when it came up for sale and was completely knocked down.

Ulster Bank then built a bank here on the same footprint and following the street profile of Main Street and St. Michael's Road.

Today (2018) the Ulster Bank operates still from this building.
