Michael Redmond of 95 Main Street Gorey died on the 25th February 1940. He is recorded as widower.

The family are buried in St. Michael's Cemetery.

The headstone reads the following inscription:

In loving memory of Michael Redmond 95 Main Street Gorey who died 25th Feb 1940. His grand-daughter Philomena Redmond who died in infancy, Cis Redmond died 29th November 1972 aged 70 years. Michael Redmond died 7th September 1975 aged 63 years. Also his wife Catherine died 29th January 1986 aged 65 years. Michael Redmond son of the above Michael and Catherine died 9th September 1992 aged 45 years. Elizabeth Katherine Lambert (nee Redmond) 1974-2005 beloved daughter of Michael and Pat.

The Fortune Family

The Fortune Family ran a successful furniture and gift store at No 95 in the latter years of the 20th century.

A hairdressing business operated here as well run by Ann Fortune.

The ESB Office operated here in the early years before it moved to the top of the town.

The building (2018) now has two parts in which shops are operating in each part; Browns Hairdressing and Phonecare.
